Locations: To begin the day, please come inside to check in your students at the First Congregational Church of Lebanon located at 588 Exeter Rd, Lebanon, CT 06249. Groups will travel by foot to several historic locations around the Green: The Lebanon Historical Society Museum & Visitor's Center, the Beaumont House and the Jonathan Trumbull Jr. House. Please ensure your students have good walking shoes, sunscreen applied prior to the day and have eaten as there will not be a meal or snack time. They are welcome to carry a water bottle to stay hydrated. Please ensure the group chaperones are aware of any allergies and if an epi-pen is required that your student carries it with them.
